Procedure Name: Post Void Residual of Urinary Bladder

Indications:

General Description:

This is a survey to determine PVR (Post Void Residual) of the Urinary Bladder.

Patient Preparation:

One hour prior to start of exam patient to drink 24 oz. of liquid

Imaging Sequence:
